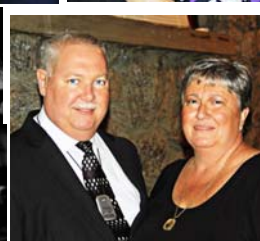

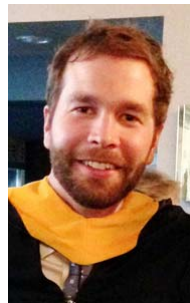


# Congratulations Alumni Graduates of Alleluia Community

selected as a Senior History Major of the Year. He plans to take a break before pursuing further education.



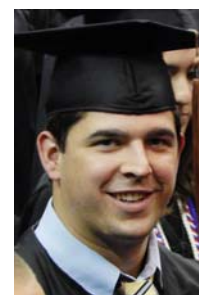
